The Corporate Planning Analyst will be focused on corporate planning and will help to support various investor relations and corporate development functions. The Commercial team is responsible for maintaining HHR's corporate modeling which is leveraged for various budgeting, reporting and scenario analysis. The candidate will have a high level of interaction with all of HHR's asset and corporate groups. The candidate will also need to possess acute attention to detail and advanced financial modeling skills with a strong understanding of financial statements and valuation methods.

Key Responsibilities:

- Update and maintain our corporate models used for internal and external reporting;
- Assist with the preparation and management of board presentations;
- Maintain and update our economic and research databases which support our analyses;
- Perform detailed financial modeling and various scenario analysis;
