### Primary Accountability:

Hammerhead Resources is seeking a dynamic and motivated Health and Safety Advisor to join our team. Our safety strategy is focused on being a Safety Leader and Partner of Choice. Reporting to the HSER Manager in Calgary, the primary role of this key position is to support Field operations by providing Health and Safety (H&S) support to our Production, Drilling, Completion and Facility Construction operations, as well as Corporate programs. This position will be working with an existing team of contract safety advisors. This position is field based out of our Grande Prairie Field Office and includes being on call for Emergency Response and Incident Investigations with frequent travel to our field locations and periodic travel to the Calgary corporate office. The ideal candidate is **required to currently live** within a maximum of a one-hour radius of our Grande Prairie Field Office.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Assist with enhancing and supporting Hammerhead's H&S programs.
- Work with all Hammerhead Operations Teams, to foster compliance with Hammerhead's expectations and H&S programs.
- Engage with vendors to continually improve and integrate our respective H&S programs in a partnership to make Hammerhead sites as safe as possible.
- In coordination with the Manager, HSE&R, lead collaboration by ensuring communication with operations, HS&E, corporate office and other cross-function stakeholders to ensure everyone is in alignment on applicable initiatives.
- Participate in incident investigations as an initial response along with the Operations representatives. This includes ensuring all investigations are completed with root cause findings and implement effective corrective actions.
- Support and create continuous improvement of our Training and Competency program for Hammerhead Leaders and Supervisors.
- Participate in and train required personnel on our Emergency Response Plan.
- Support Simultaneous Operation's projects by coordinating with On Site Representatives to help facilitate hazard assessments and aid in emergency response planning.
- Participate in pre-job kickoff meetings as well as HSE reviews post-job.
- Support and participate in industry and synergy groups as required.

### Requirements and Key Competencies:

- Must have minimum 10 years' experience in the Oil & Gas industry with a minimum of 7 years in H&S.
- Must have H&S experience in Drilling, Completions and/or Production/Facilities/Operations.
- Experience with building and improving H&S standards and practices.
- Preference will be given to a Canadian Registered Safety Professional (CRSP), with consideration for those currently holding an OH&S Certificate or University Equivalent.
- Must have a background or training in Incident Investigation.
- Motivated to support all aspects of our Operations with continual enhancement of our H&S programs.
- Must be able to manage time and priorities.
- Advanced communication skills, including written, verbal and computer.
- Demonstrate a keen interest for accuracy and have a strong attention to detail.
- Have strong organizational skills and excellent critical thinking skills.

- Possess the ability to work as a great team player, provide professional input, and effectively support and work with Hammerhead Leaders.
- Regular travel required from our Grande Prairie Office to our operational areas with periodic travel to Calgary.
